Director of Music Report February meeting 2022

Welcome back to another year of hopefully performing!

At present we have started rehearsals for senior band and even though our numbers have been smaller than usual, there has been some quality playing occurring.

Once school returns, our COS band will recommence for another year and in the intervening period between 5.45 and 7.00 initially I would like to run some sectional rehearsals for our concert and contest pieces to tighten them even further. Following our commitments to concert and contest, I would like to see our dance band recommence rehearsal in that spot on a fortnightly basis and on the opposite week run perhaps and adult learners' group or alternate ensemble. I would prefer not to conduct the learner's group but use the time to encourage others to have a go.

As far as performances go, I feel that once again this year we will be subject to changes and cancellations by other organisations that book our services, therefore once again it will be important that we as a band take control of our performances and not be reliant on the traditional venues and functions for performance opportunities.
