Resumption of Rehearsals Covid-19 Safety 2021

1. Everyone attending a rehearsal must be 100% (double) Covid1919 vaccinated or hold a valid medical exemption.
2. Everyone aged 12 years and over attending a rehearsal must be prepared to show evidence of their vaccination status. Failure to do so will render the person ineligible to attend. Abuse of the supervising or any other person attending the venue will not be tolerated and will result in non-admittance to the venue.
3. Everyone attending a rehearsal must be signed in on the Covid-19 register upon arrival at the venue. This register will be maintained each rehearsal for the foreseeable future. The band will operate their own specific QR code in addition to any requirement of the Senior Citizens Management staff.
4. If a member:
 - a. experience symptoms consistent with Covid-19 they are directed not to attend the rehearsal or any function of the band until fully fit. They are to notify the secretary, DOM or President as a matter of urgency and seek suitable testing. (Symptoms can range from mild illness to pneumonia. People with coronavirus may experience fever, flu-like symptoms such as coughing, sore throat, fatigue and shortness of breath. If you are sick and think you have symptoms of COVID-19, seek medical attention. If you want to talk to someone about your symptoms first, call the Coronavirus Health Information Line for advice on 1800 020 080).
 - b. has been advised by health officials to isolate, they are not to return to any band function until cleared by NSW Health officials.
5. Hand sanitiser will be provided and may be used throughout the rehearsal as required.
6. Everyone attending the venue must adhere to current social distancing regulations. Players are requested to provide their own music and stand so that they are not sharing or needing to work closely together (unless they are from the same household).
7. Players are responsible for any fluids leaking from their instrument. Please bring a towel or other suitable equipment to clean up your own mess. Towels and any wipes used must be removed from the premises at the end of rehearsal.
8. Surfaces will be wiped down with hospital grade disinfectant at the end of the rehearsal. This will help ensure that chairs are disinfected prior to use.
9. Non-playing visitors are requested to wear a suitable mask whilst in the premises and members are asked to comply with current mask wearing requirements whilst entering or leaving the premises.
10. In accordance with Government sanctions, there will be a limit of 50 people onsite at any one time (the 1 per 4sq metre allows a maximum of 75 people in the Senior Citizens).
